- Verbal and written directions are given to virtual students, as well as communication with parents to
 explain the independent learning activities.
- In the classroom, I can work directly with individual students to chunk material, give extra time, and
 provide extension activities that are individualized for the students.
- I have improved my wait time to allow student to think and question the students further so that they
 can extend their thinking.
- Verbal responses to questions are given to virtual students so that they can record their ideas and
 make connections to their world and the new learning. *Recordings are on Schoology*
- Student in the classroom can show what they know by directly interacting with materials and
 explaining their thought processes.
